



Need Help Paying Your Gas Bill?

If you're having difficulty paying your natural gas bill, the Gas Assistance Fund (GAF) may be able to provide you, or someone you know, with a one-time grant for the amount of the gas bill, not to exceed \$400.00. If the eligible applicant is age 55+ or has an older adult (55+) living in the household, an additional \$100 is available for a maximum grant of up to \$500. Additionally, those facing certain financial hardships may be eligible for extra grant funding. Make an appointment with your **local agency** to see what your household may qualify for:

The Gas Assistance Fund is a joint effort of SoCalGas® and United Way of Greater Los Angeles. United Way works with non-profit organizations throughout our service territory to manage the program.

How to Qualify

To qualify for GAF, you must meet the following requirements:

- . The natural gas bill must be in the name of the applicant requesting assistance
- · The bill address must be the applicant's primary residence
- The applicant must not apply for more than the maximum GAF allowance for the current program year
- · The applicant must meet the income guidelines listed below

Non-Recurring Short Term Benefits

In order to be eligible, families must meet the following criteria:

- Be an American Indian/Alaska Native family residing in Fresno, Inyo, Kern, Kings, Mono, Tulare or Ventura counties.
- Have monthly income at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines:
